



RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the health and safety of Hillsborough County students is the School Board's priority; and

WHEREAS, the School District of Hillsborough County strives to protect the safety of thousands of young students walking to school and to bus stops; and

WHEREAS, children face a disproportionate risk of traffic injuries and fatalities; and

WHEREAS, people walking and bicycling represent a disproportionate number of fatalities, and in 2014 nearly half of the people who died in crashes in Tampa were pedestrians; and

WHEREAS, Vision Zero is the concept that there is no acceptable number of traffic deaths and serious injuries on our streets; and

WHEREAS, Vision Zero has been proven highly successful, based on the simple fact that we are all human and make mistakes, the road system needs to keep us moving, but it must also be designed to protect us at every turn; and

WHEREAS, since setting the Vision Zero initiative in motion in 1997, Sweden has experienced a 42% reduction in traffic fatalities. Similarly, Switzerland has seen a 41% drop, Germany a 45% drop, France a 48% drop, and Spain a 53% decline in fatalities; and

WHEREAS, cities across the United States, including New York, Boston, Seattle, Portland, San Francisco, San Jose, Los Angeles and San Diego are adopting Vision Zero policies and plans with the intent of eliminating fatal and serious crashes from their streets. In its first year of implementing Vision Zero, New York City has seen the lowest number of pedestrian fatalities since documentation began in 1910; and

WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Transportation, through the Mayors' Challenge for Safer People, Safer Streets has challenged Mayors and local elected officials across the country to take significant action on improving the safety transportation networks for pedestrians and bicyclists of all ages and abilities; and

WHEREAS, the Tampa City Council adopted a Resolution supporting Vision Zero in December, 2015.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SCHOOL BOARD OF HILLSBOROUGH COUNTY, FLORIDA

Section 1. That the School Board of Hillsborough County supports the goal of the Vision Zero initiative, to define road safety summarized in one sentence, "No loss of life is acceptable."

Section 2. That the School Board of Hillsborough County expresses support for the development and implementation of a Vision Zero Action Plan for the City of Tampa, and urges the Mayor to engage City staff to develop and establish a Vision Zero Action Plan for the benefit of the students of the School District of Hillsborough County.
