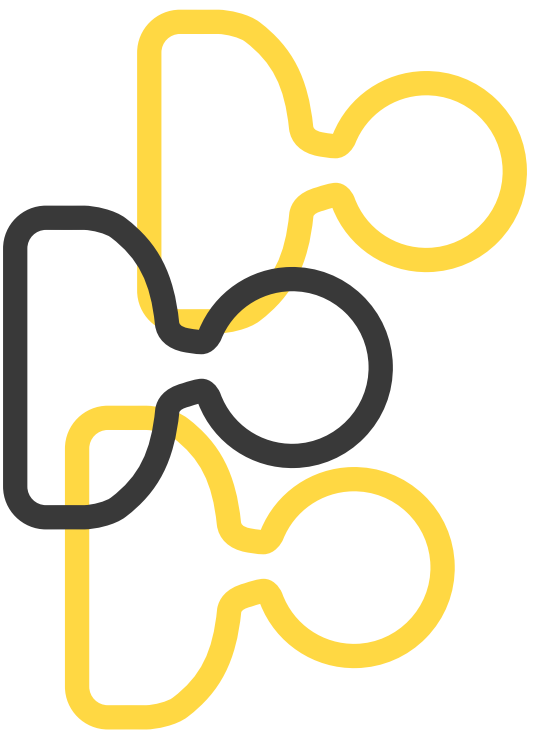

# WHAT ARE OUR REQUIREMENTS?

LAWS, REGULATIONS, AND AGENCY POLICIES

● CORE REQUIREMENTS FROM:  
2015 FAST ACT (23 CFR 450.210 & 450.316)

● ADDITIONALLY FROM:  
OTHER LAWS- STATE AND FEDERAL  
EXECUTIVE ORDERS  
YOUR OWN AGENCY POLICIES

- EARLY AND CONTINUOUS OPPORTUNITIES TO ENGAGE
- STAKEHOLDER IDENTIFICATION
- DIGITALLY AVAILABLE INFORMATION
- PUBLIC INPUT ON ALL ASPECTS OF PLANNING
- ACCESSIBLE LOCATIONS AND ACTIVITIES
- PUBLIC MEETINGS AND HEARINGS
- PROHIBITING DISCRIMINATION
- LIMITED-ENGLISH-PROFICIENCY
- PUBLIC PARTICIPATION PLAN, PROCESS AND PROCEDURES
- KEY MATTERS OF PUBLIC INTEREST
- PUBLIC TRANSIT
- PUBLIC RECORD KEEPING
- TRADITIONALLY UNDERSERVED
- TRIBAL
- VISUALIZATION

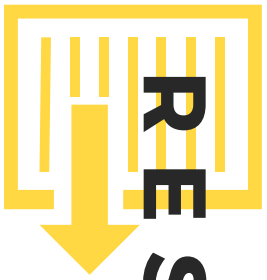
